Cary Memorial Library Patron Code of Conduct

To ensure that all patrons may have safe and comfortable use of the Cary Memorial Library and the Williams House, appropriate behavior is expected. Violation of any of the following rules will result in a warning and/or expulsion from the property. Whenever necessary, police will be contacted. Library staff or their designee covering the library have authority to carry out all powers of this policy.

- No destruction or mutilation of library property.
- No use of tobacco products.
- No parking bicycles or other vehicles parked in a manner that hinders entry to the library.
- No skateboarding, snowboarding, or biking on the library campus.
- No conduct which is disruptive to the operation of the library or threatening to patrons, staff, or library property. Includes sleeping, abusive language, loud disorderly behavior, loitering, etc.
- Cell phones must be silenced in the library building. If you need to make a call, please use your phone outdoors or in your vehicle.
- Use of the library's WiFi or computers assumes you have read and understood our Internet Safety Policy posted at the computer station.
- Restrooms used for intended purposes only.
- No theft or vandalism of library property.
- Shirts and shoes required.
- No weapons are permitted on library property.
- No food or drink while using library computers and handling books.
